## Agenda

With respect to the individual identities of the programmes co-organising the Conference, the Agenda consists of sessions directly responding to each programme's subject as well as sessions that are common for all. More specifically:

• <u>Day 1</u>, and after a brief opening session that will set the objectives of the Conference, the day will be fully dedicated to discussing the way towards an investment-prone environment, to sharing and disseminating experiences and best practices on governance and sustainable financing in the water sector.

From a programme implementation perspective, this day will represent the '3rd Regional Conference on Governance & Financing for the Mediterranean Water Sector', as stated in the 'Governance and Financing for the Mediterranean water sector' project document, as well as the regional activity 'Promoting the role of green banking in supporting investments in the water sector, particularly with the involvement of private banks' under the SWIM-H2020 SM Workplan.

- <u>Day 2</u> will be dedicated to promoting water integrity and sharing knowledge as well as lessons learned on integrating more transparency, accountability and participation in water services delivery and resources management.
   From a programme implementation perspective, this day will represent the 'Water Integrity MENA Learning Summit', as stated in the 'Regional Water Integrity Capacity Building Programme' documents.
- <u>Day 3</u> will be dedicated to the way forward for the overall water governance agenda in the Region. Discussions at national and regional level will develop roadmaps for policy processes and desired actions, addressing together the subjects of sustainable financing and water integrity. The way-forward working sessions will be followed by a panel discussion, discussing the strategic orientation and the required actions to progress in strengthening water governance and accessing financing resources, as well as in building institutional capacities in water integrity. Day 3 will conclude the Regional Conference with a high-level closing session delivering a conference statement to the UfM.
