Article 2.3.3 Communications during the procurement procedure

If the candidate has any questions regarding the call for proposals, please contact GWPO via email procurement@gwp.org. GWPO will respond via email to any request for clarification of the call for proposals that it receives prior to the closing date for proposals. GWPO's response to all questions (including an explanation of the query but without identifying the source of enquiry) will be sent to all candidates.

Q: My main question is if there is a possibility for applying for this consultancy as a team of 2 or 3 people, perhaps then administratively as an association, would such applications be considered?

Answer: It is possible to apply as a team to this consultancy.

Q: Also, regarding the interviews for deliverable 2, though it is obvious this task can be done online, would it still be interesting if certain fieldwork is included, hence adding the observation of the concrete cases into the framework?

Answer: The applicants can propose the methodology that they think will work best to achieve the targeted results.

Q: Is it a requirement for all team members to have more than 15 years of experience in their area of expertise? Would it be enough if one team member, e.g., our team leader, has more than 15 years of experience?

Answer: It can be enough to have only one team member having more than 15 years of experience. This would depend on how the team is set up and how the tasks would be shared.

NEW Q: We would like to know if the programmatic approach will be focused in the programmatic funding or if it will be more centered in your anchor areas.

Answer: The programmatic approach should identify key pathways to contribute to the implementation of GWP strategy, in connection with one or several of its anchor areas, in a way that should also be attractive in terms of raising programmatic funding.
