Evans Njewa Environmental Affairs Department GCF NDA Office Malawi GCF NAP Readiness was approved in March 2019 – 1st submission in June 2017; followed by 4 resubmissions in 2018

21 months; 4 rounds of review; 30 pages of review comments

Grant is US\$2.8 million for 3 years

Level of justification required

- 1. Evidence of vulnerability of the people, economic sectors
- 2. Availability of scientific data to justify proposal threats and shocks; loss of livelihoods, life, damage to property & infrastructure from disasters; displacement of people, etc.
- 3. Climate risk assessments to inform adaptation planning
- 4.Level of proposal content and budget detail excessive
- 5. Small margin allowed for adaptive management meaning Secretariat holds the key for details required in the proposal
- 6. Project activities and output plan may require more detailed information

3. Sectors wrangling as to which sector is vulnerable – to benefit
