



Launch of the 2023 Global Water Changemakers Awards:

Event to be hosted by K-water in Collaboration with Convenors of the Changemakers, Global Water Partnership and Word Bank Group during the official kickoff event of the 3rd Asia International Water Week (AIWW).

1.0 Background

On 6 July 2023, the Global Water Changemakers Awards 2023 will be launched in South Korea during the official kick-off event of the International Asian Water Week Global, the largest gathering on water in Asia. The Global Water Changemakers Award is a global initiative that aims to recognise high-level commitment and leadership for climate resilient water investments and showcase the most promising climate resilient innovations with the greatest potential for scale, replication, and further investment to support a water-secure world.

The Changemakers Awards includes (i) the Presidential Changemakers Award - for demonstrated leadership and commitment; (ii) Innovation Changemakers Award- for the most promising climate innovations; (iii) Youth Water Changemakers Award-for demonstrating commitment to social change.

The Global Water Changemakers Award was announced by HE Mokgweetsi Masisi, President of Botswana, Chair of the Global Changemakers Award on 22 March 2023 during the UN Water Conference in New York. HE Mokgweetsi Masisi, also presented the Presidential Global Water Changemakers Awards to six current and former Heads of State.

Four co-chairs of the International High-Level Panel on Water Investments for Africa; H.E Macky Sall, President of the Republic of Senegal and Chair of the African Union, H.E Hage Geingob, President of Namibia, H.E Mark Rutte, Prime Minister of the Netherlands and H.E Jakaya Kikwete, Former President of the Republic of Tanzania each received the Presidential Global Changemakers Award for demonstrating high level political commitment and leadership for climate resilient water security in Africa. HE Hakainde Hichilema, President of the Republic of Zambia and HE Dr. Hussein Ali Mwinyi, President of Zanzibar also received the award for local country leadership following the launch of their national Water Investment Programs.

2.0 High Level Launch of the 2023 Global Water Changemakers

On 6 July 2023, K-water, the leading South Korean water resources corporation, will host the global high-level launch of the 2023 Global Water Changemakers Innovation Awards in Songsan, South Korea. A paradigm shift in water investments is required to access new sources of innovative finance. Investment in climate-resilient water security and sanitation has an economic return of USD \$7 for every USD \$ 1 invested. Investing in a water secure future now will realise human security, a healthy environment, amplify gender equality, health, energy, education, food security, and many other societal gains for this generation – and those to come.

2.1 Opportunity to enhance investment for scaling up

The launch of the Global Water Changemakers Awards 2023 will initiate a global competition for the most promising climate innovations that can be scaled up through further investment promotion. The changemakers will seek innovations that have already proven their business model by operating for at least 1 year. Selected Water Changemakers will receive technical assistance and seed funding to scale up their innovations and strengthen their business and investment case for investors.

The Water Changemaker Awards will bring together the supply and demand for innovative finance with a special focus on climate resilient, blended public-private finance, and gender transformative approaches. The initiative promotes the most promising climate resilient innovations to enable them to access new and innovative finance sources from institutional investors, debt, equity, and others from private and public sources, to enable them to scale up.

2.2 Expected outcomes of the High-Level Launch of Changemakers

The expected outcomes of the High-Level Launch of the global water changemakers are:

- i. Formally launch the competition for the global changemakers innovation Awards.
- ii. Vision Statement on the global water changemakers and roadmap for 2023 Changemakers unveiled towards the inaugural water changemakers summit COP 28 during , in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.
- iii. Transformative climate resilient water innovations showcased; advances in sensor technology, computing, artificial intelligence, big data nature-based systems for informing operational decisions by policy makers and water management companies.
- iv. Promote and showcase transformative initiatives from the UN Water Conference such as the Continental Africa Water Investment Programme (AIP), water investment scorecard and the pyramid of water investment transformation by the AIP international High-Level Panel.

Innovations that involve all stakeholders, public, private, and communities must be identified and scaled up to drive a momentum change for a water secure and climate resilient world. Promising climate innovations must be identified and nurtured to have significant impact on today's water challenges and lead to tomorrow's water-secure world. Promising climate innovations exist, but many of them fail before reaching the scale at which they can make significant impact.

Draft Agenda

Led by the convenors of the Global Changemakers, Global Water Partnership, World Bank Group and K-water, the launch if the changemakers will include high level invited personalities.

Recent laureates of the Presidential changemakers awards as well as winners of the 2020 Changemakers will be invited to participate virtually. The launch will take place on 6 July 2023 in Songsan following the meetings of the fourth Asian Water Council General Assembly, as part of the official kick-off of the 3rd Asia International Water Week (AIWW).
