1. I noted that there is no minimum education qualification listed under the WRM and CC Specialists. Is that how it is supposed to be?	<p>The qualification is updated as follow:</p> <p>Water Resources Specialist: Minimum qualification of a Bachelor degree in Water Resources Management, Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM), Natural Resources Management, Water Resources Engineering, or related fields with 10 years of experience in integrated planning, <u>watershed management</u>, <u>water resources modelling</u>, decision-support systems, and transboundary basin management.</p> <p>Climate Change Specialist: Minimum qualification of a Bachelor degree in Environmental Science or Environmental Management, Climate Change and Sustainable Development, Environmental Policy/Climate Policy. Proven skills in scenario development, impact assessment, and modelling under IPCC frameworks</p>
2. On p7 of the ToR, the following is stated: “The Team as a collective must be fluent in both Portuguese and English ...”. Kindly can you confirm whether this is a requirement for <u>all</u> key experts?	<p>It is not a requirement that every individual expert be fluent in both Portuguese and English. What we meant in the ToR is that, as a team collectively, there should be sufficient capacity to work effectively in both languages ensuring that the assignment can be carried out seamlessly across both language contexts.</p>
