GWP's vision is a water secure world. Its mission is to advance governance and management of water resources for sustainable and equitable development.

GWP's partnership – more than 3,000 organizations in over 180 countries structured around 13 regional and 60 country water partnerships – is an agenda-setting platform for water management. The partnership mobilises knowledge, financing, and programme implementation to ensure good water governance by applying integrated water resources management (IWRM).

GWP is at the intersection of the global development agendas: delivering sustainable water management (SDG 6) through a partnership (SDG 17) that supports countries to deliver on their climate commitments (Paris Agreement) and which furthers disaster risk reduction and resilience (Sendai Framework).

In its current strategy period (2014-19), GWP has influenced more than 170 water governance outcomes which in turn have delivered water-related investments of more than €1.2 billion. As a result, approximately 60 million people have benefited from better water management.
