IWRM UN Water Rio+20 Data Analysis

- Initial correlation results of IWRM UN Water Rio+20 database with GWP countries is a good start
- Continue with proposal as recommended in November 2012:
 - Select 1 good example from each region for an internal assessment as case studies
 - From cases above, do one or more in-depth assessments of performance and value for money through the results/knowledge chain

GWP Thematic Programmes

- Appreciate the evolution of the implementation of GWP's Strategy through thematic programmes, notably:
 - Water and Climate
 - Transboundary, and
 - Urbanisation.
- Strategy 2020 and added themes may require review of results-indicators with new or modified indicators required

Water and Climate Programme

- Discussed challenges and risks in programme implementation with time limitations and limited capacities - noted
- Suggest focusing on selected regional/country projects with early deliverables to demonstrate the viability of the Water and Climate Programme
 - also select the best institutional partners to deliver quick/easy results
- Examine alternative short-term tactics to ensure projects are delivered in a timely manner:
 - e.g. working with innovative partners such as HR Wallingford, IWMI, NASA, FEWSNet (USAID), Japan, etc.

Water and Climate Programme

- Recommend that the financial partners are made aware of the unrealistic nature of the present time limitations for programme implementation – e.g. March 2015
- Recommend GWP senior management commence ASAP *strategic dialogues* with Financing Partners
 - e.g. DFID for a 2 yr no-cost extension beyond March 2015
