


# 2020 reporting on global status of IWRM

**Timeline** Reporting throughout 2020

Survey 33 questions on status of IWRM implementation


Number of reports submitted 171

Total number of datasets for analysis 186 (including 2017 baseline reports without an update)



# Main findings I

- Increase in the global average score from 49% (2017) to 54% (2020) out of 100
- Global average changed from Medium-low to Medium-high




# Main findings II


- Implementation levels are lowest in Latin America and the Caribbean, Oceania, Central and Southern Asia, and Sub-Saharan Africa

- Financing still the lowest scoring dimension
- The most commonly cited barriers to IWRM implementation:
- Political will and commitment
- Lack of coordination;
- Insufficient financing;
- Weak capacity;
- Insufficient monitoring;
- Ineffective legal frameworks;


# Key messages



1. Globally, the rate of implementation of IWRM urgently needs to double




2. Real and rapid progress is possible

**Carry out the Action Plan** to ensure measurable progress on SDG 6.5.1 and other SDG targets, feeding back into the reporting process (stage 1)






