

A. Program Planning Phase:

1. Identify knowledge needs

1. Challenges and barriers
2. Needs

2. Identify intended audience

1. Policy makers, Technical staff, communities, private, media, Learning Institutions

3. Knowledge partners (Universities, Research, Govt. Private sector, CSOs, communities (including Indigenous knowledge), UN agencies

4. Identify knowledge sources

5. Review available knowledge and identify gaps

B. Program Implementation Phase:

1. Knowledge deliverables
2. Package existing knowledge to facilitate learning

C. Dissemination and use

- Develop communications strategy and channels
 - Different languages
 - Packaging for different levels and different audiences
- Define methodology for knowledge management
- Monitor usage of the knowledge
