Eligibility requirements

Scholarship candidates must have:

- 1. A completed undergraduate degree in a related field of study from an internationally-recognised institution, and
- 2. At least two years of professional experience (paid work or volunteering) relevant to the program, and
- 3. International candidates must also demonstrate English Language Proficiency - eg. IELTS, TOEFL or PTE test or any alternative proof of English Language Proficiency as per The University of Queensland's Policy.
