Following the kick-off of Water Safety Planning (WSP) development in the Caribbean in Jamaica (Spanish Town water supply system) in 2006, The Caribbean Environmental Health Institute (CEHI) provided technical support for implementation of a Water Safety Planning Initiative for the city of Linden, Guyana, in close technical partnership and guidance from the United States Centre for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Since then CEHI has supported the St. Lucia Water and Sewage Company (WASCO) in implementing a Water Safety Plan (WSP) for the water supply systems that service the Mabouya Valley and Dennery communities in St. Lucia
