The Convention is supplemented by three Protocols: (i) the Protocol Concerning Co-operation in Combating Oil Spills in the Wider Caribbean Region (ii) Protocol Concerning Specially Protected Areas and Wildlife (SPAW) in the Wider Caribbean Region and (iii) Protocol Concerning Pollution from Land-Based Sources and Activities. Some Caribbean IWRM activities are executed by UNEP at the Global Level specifically through the Freshwater and Marine Ecosystems Branch of the Division of Environmental Policy Implementation based in Nairobi, Kenya. Issues such as Gender and Water, Climate Change and Water Security are of high priority in UNEP's work globally and regionally.
