

Main goal: to discuss the project results; to consider the structure of the regional technical report "Distribution of transboundary water resources. Ecological flow - the basis for the conservation of aquatic ecosystems"; to analyze the basic situation and the current state of water distribution in Central Asia; and to share visions of stakeholders on the current state of interstate (transboundary) cooperation and water distribution with neighboring countries.
