Description of the activity

Compendium of good practices will include a review of drought management projects implemented in European countries (not limited to participating countries). We will explore the existing documents about drought management across Europe. Some Drought Management Plans (DM plans) already exist and our goal is to analyse the current status of the existing NAPs and to represent them. These countries are Greece, Italy, Portugal, Spain and others. We will also analyse other existing drought policy and management documents besides DM plans of SE countries (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Macedonia, Hungary, Montenegro, Moldova, Romania, Greece, Turkey and Slovenia).

We will contact focal points of DMCSSE and Activity leaders of current project – *Integrated Drought Management in Central and Eastern Europe* with interview about drought policy and management in their countries/regions/organisation. Cooperation with European Drought Centre, European Drought Observatory, DMCSSE, UNECE and other relevant institutions will be initiated.

It is expected that activity leaders will contribute to this publication. Publication is envisaged as mix of existing information and accomplishments of this project. Mainly success stories from WP2 and WP5 are expected to be described in the publication.

Publication will be compound of activities result from Integrated Drought Management in Central and Eastern Europe:

- Review of the current status of the implementation of DM plans and measures within RBMP according to WFD;
- Drought information exchange Platform;
- Guidelines for Drought Management Plans;
- Drought management by agricultural practices and measures-increasing soil water holding capacity;
- Assessment of drought impact on forest ecosystems;
- Natural small water retention measures;
- Drought Risk Management Scheme: a decision support system;
- Policy oriented study on remote sensing agricultural drought monitoring methods;
- Upgrading agricultural drought monitoring and forecasting: the case of Ukraine and Moldova.

Publication will be prepared by the end of June 2015. The publication, as an IDMP CEE knowledge



product, will link up with GWP knowledge management and especially GWP ToolBox. In addition, demonstration projects from the compendium will be developed into GWP ToolBox studies.

The aim of this activity is to prepare a publication **Compendium of Good Practices.** Publication is envisaged as mix of existing information and accomplishments of this project.
