Project Summary and Meeting Objectives

As identified under Phase I, one of the key challenges with strong cross-sectoral implications and potential in Albania is the need to rehabilitate Albania's Irrigation and Drainage infrastructure and in particular the many reservoirs.

The objective of the Phase-II Nexus Assessment is to provide:

- A detailed assessment of options for capturing synergies across different sectors in the rehabilitation of a specific reservoir and related infrastructure, to the level of a pre-feasibility study.
- Preparation of guidelines and an Action Plan for the replication and upscaling of such interventions in Albania.

The focus of this project is the Çorrush 1 reservoir, located in the municipality of Mallakastër. This reservoir was constructed in 1967. Initially, it was designed to irrigate 480 hectares; however, it currently only meets the irrigation needs of about 200–250 hectares. The analysis conducted during the project's first phase highlighted several issues, including: deterioration of the irrigation and drainage network, erosion of the dam body, sedimentation within the reservoir, etc.

The main objective of the project is to assess the potential for converting this single-purpose, with limited operationality reservoir into a multipurpose one. Through this study, we will analyze opportunities to: improve the irrigation and drainage systems, expand the irrigated area, enhance dam safety, modernize water distribution infrastructure, and identify other potential uses such as energy production or ecotourism development.

The implementation of the project is structured into three main phases:

Inception Phase

- Identification of reservoir of focus (completed with the selection of Corrush 1 reservoir)
- Preparation of an Inception Report (completed)

Implementation phase

- Organization of the first Multi-stakeholder Consultation Meeting (this meeting)
- Collection of detailed data
- Identification of a portfolio of options of interventions
- Development of a detailed and quantified proposal of a set of interventions
- Identification of potential financing sources or instruments
- Organization of the second Multi-stakeholder Consultation Meeting

Final phase

- Phase II Nexus Assessment Report
- Development of an Action Plan
