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# **Scope of the Roadmap**

- Ultimate goal: Ensure policy integration to maximise benefits across sectors
- A Framework to facilitate a more integrated and coherent approach across sectors
  - in the design and prioritisation of management practices, policy and regulatory frameworks, investment and infrastructure planning...
- Stemming from the Nexus Assessment
- A "living" document –simple in structure- to be discussed, adjusted, enhanced



# Structure of the Roadmap

- 8 objectives and suggested main lines of action to achieve them
- Objectives 1- 3: of general nature, common for all types of "Nexus issues"
- Objectives 4-8: pertain to the principal objectives of each Nexus sector
  - suggesting lines of action for addressing the considerations of other sectors and capturing related synergies



#### 1. Enhance knowledge and capacities

- Create and share knowledge on methodologies, technologies, innovations
- Develop quantitative Nexus Assessments for specific interlinkages at local and levels
- Ensure data availability and monitoring, use of appropriate indicators of cross-sectoral relevance
- Facilitate capacity building for decision makers, key stakeholders and staff - Promote vocational training in Nexus-related skills



- 2. Strengthen cross-sectoral cooperation, governance and coherent policymaking
  - Role & capacities of Inter-ministerial Bodies and Groups
  - Efficient and clear definition of mandates and roles
  - Harmonise data across sectors, facilitate data sharing
  - Develop recommendations & instruments for increasing cross-sectorality in policy-making
    - E.g. SEAs for all strategies, integrated permitting process, public participation requirements, rules for intersectoral coordination and consultation
  - ❖ Facilitate the engagement of local authorities & stakeholders



- 3. Enable planning and implementation of Nexus solutions
  - Coordinated strategic planning for infrastructure development
    - o capturing opportunities from international frameworks such as the Green Agenda for WBs, EU's Instruments for Pre-Accession Assistance
  - Leverage & facilitate financing for Nexus interventions
  - Enabling environment, market instruments, entrepreneurship
  - Pilot no-regret interventions. Replicate/upscale success stories Engage the private sector



- 4. Enhance water resources management addressing the needs of all uses
  - Develop-finalise-adopt-implement RBMPs
    - Ensure consistency with parallel planning activities (Integrated Coastal Zones Management plans, Urban and/or Rural development plans)
  - Ensure institutional cooperation both "horizontally" and "vertically"
    - o data collection-processing-sharing
    - Planning
    - o implementation and monitoring
  - Enhance cooperation with neighbouring countries towards transboundary RBMPs



- 5. Expand and improve access to WSS services, capturing cross-sectoral synergies
  - Energy efficiency in infrastructure & equipment Reduce water loss
  - Energy recovery & on-site RES, as applicable
  - Facilitate synergies with agriculture (treated water / sludge)
  - Promote Nature-based Solutions for wastewater treatment in small settlements



- 6. Meeting Energy and Climate goals addressing the considerations of all sectors
  - Spatial Planning for renewable energy
    - EIAs, International best practices
  - Operation of large HPPs consider flood management
  - Diversify from hydro assess effect of Climate Change
  - Address sedimentation in reservoirs
  - Assess conflicts biofuels food security & resource availability
  - Sectoral efficiency measures (irrigation, WSS, heating)
  - Small scale RES in other sectors (also locally owned)



- 7. Improve and modernize irrigation and drainage services with cross-sectoral benefits
  - Maximise efficiencies in water and energy use minimise use of pesticides
  - RES opportunities in agriculture
  - Assess the potential for energy cultivations
  - Facilitate engagement & role of WUOs; raise awareness and enhance capacities of farmers and stakeholders



- 8. Enhance the protection of biodiversity & natural areas addressing cross-sectoral conflicts and pressures
  - Improve & mainstream SEA / EIA processes for all infrastructure development as well as sectoral strategies
  - Management Plans for all protected areas following international best practices & guidelines
  - National/Regional Spatial Planning for renewable energy
  - Update regulations on environmental flows for HPPs Ensure sufficient water for Ecosystem services in all cases of water allocation and permitting
  - Land restoration initiatives using NbS
  - Sustainable forest management and wood biomass harvesting
