



Integrated activities

That projects with other overall objectives use the gender/ CSR/environment glasses to formulate indicators, activities etc.

Example - gender: use of disaggregated statistics, taking norms and triple roles into account in planning, considering who have access/control/benefit from resourcs and if project reinforce these patterns — all that you lift in a gender analysis.



Targeted activities

Projects (with other overall objectives) can have a specific component to deal with gender/CSR (e.g. Targeting managers to increase recruitment of women, increase awarenss on participatory methodologies with a gender perspective).



Dialogue

- Essentially a communication strategy
 - Target groups of dialogue
 - Objective of dialogue, when, why, who
 - Different strategies and entry points with

different target groups/objectives

WB adm environmental project with MoE and MARDWA (impl.) Sida financed gender and stakeholder engagement monitoring

The Project Development Objective (PDO) is to support sustainable land management practices and increase communities' monetary and non-monetary benefits, in targeted project areas which are mainly in erosion prone rural upland areas.
