## The survey was conducted during June 2021 for the needs of the workshop “Gender dimension in the sustainable management of natural resources through a Nexus approach in the Drina river basin”

- The number of participants: 59 (40 female, 17 male, 2 did not specify)
- The participants from the countries of the Drina river basin:



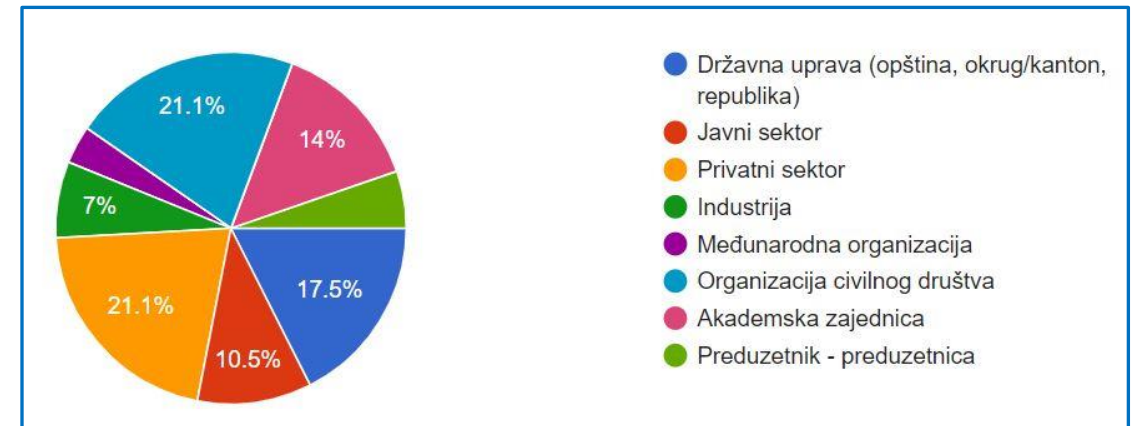
BiH: 48%



Serbia: 45%

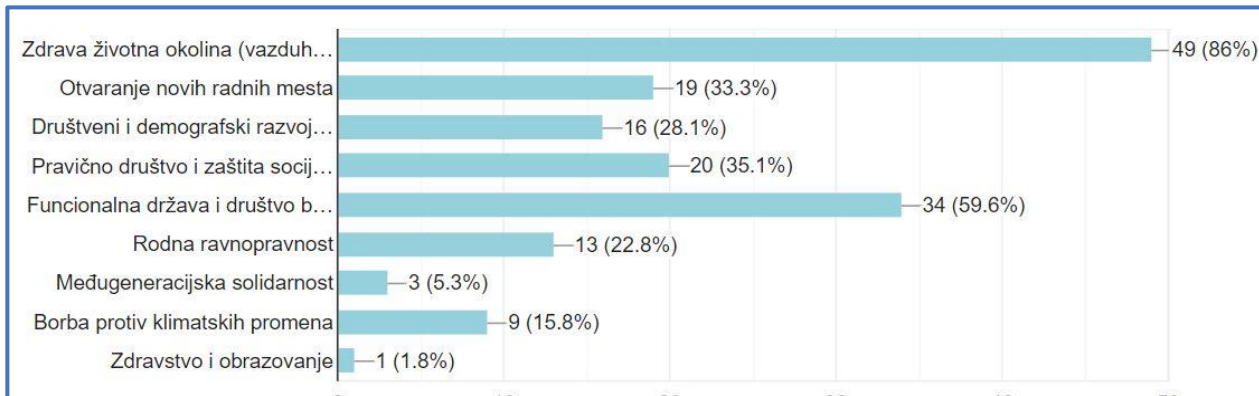


Montenegro: 7%

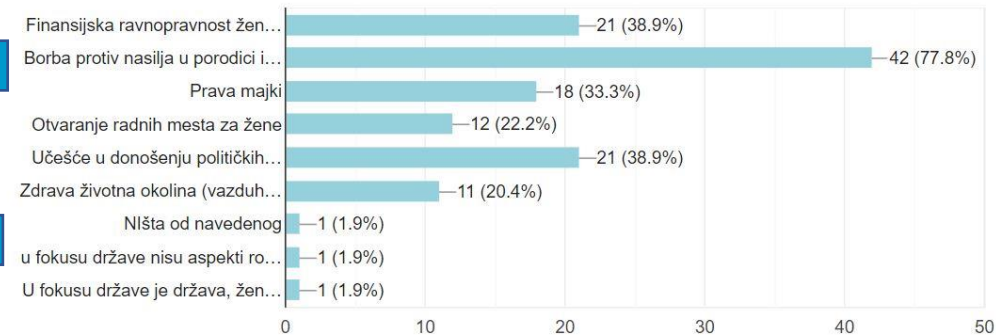

- Nothing stated: 1 (1.9%)



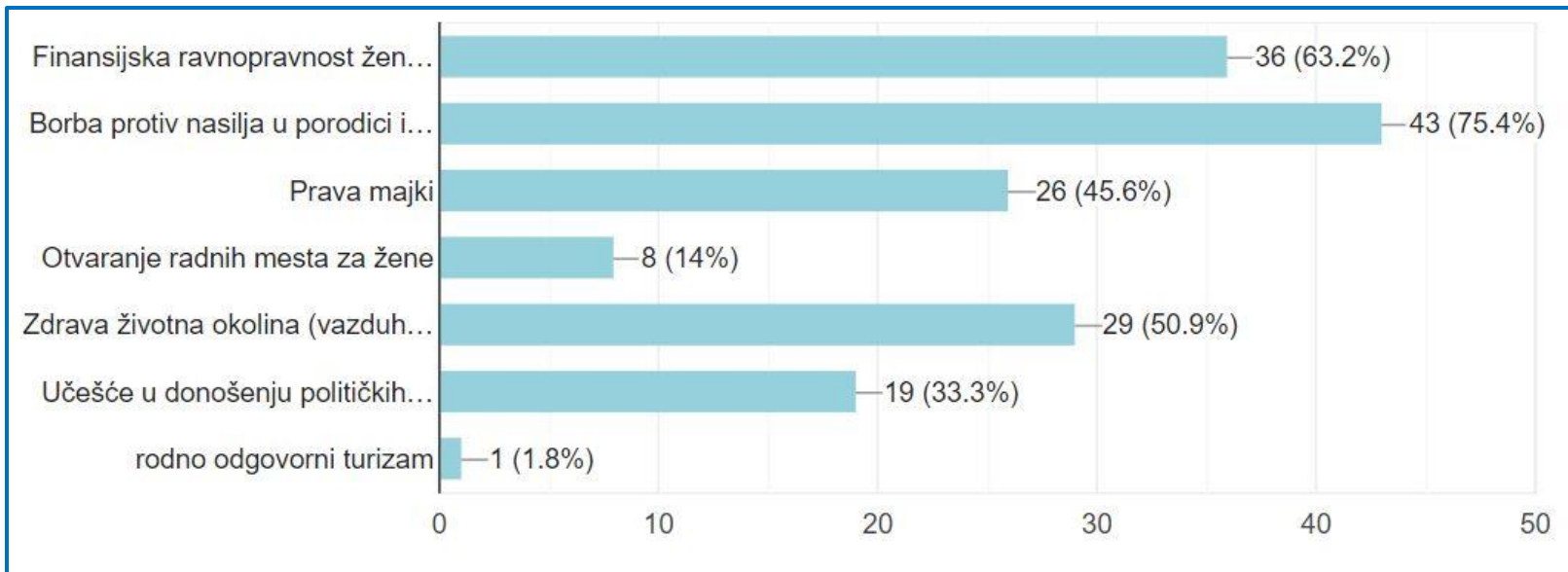
*„The state does not focus on gender mainstreaming. It is recognized in the laws, but the laws are not implemented. In public sector, gender equality cannot be identified.”*

*„U fokusu države je država. Žene se zloupotrebljavaju u smislu kreiranja lažne slike brige o njima.“*

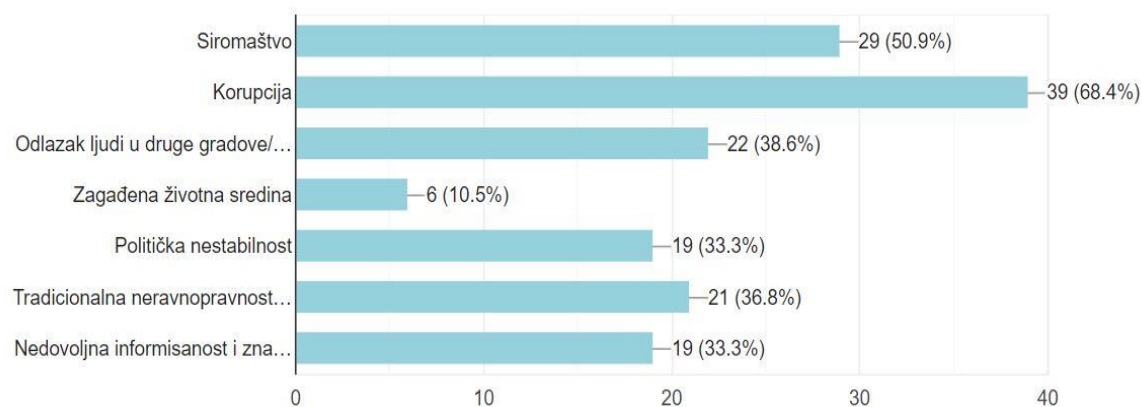

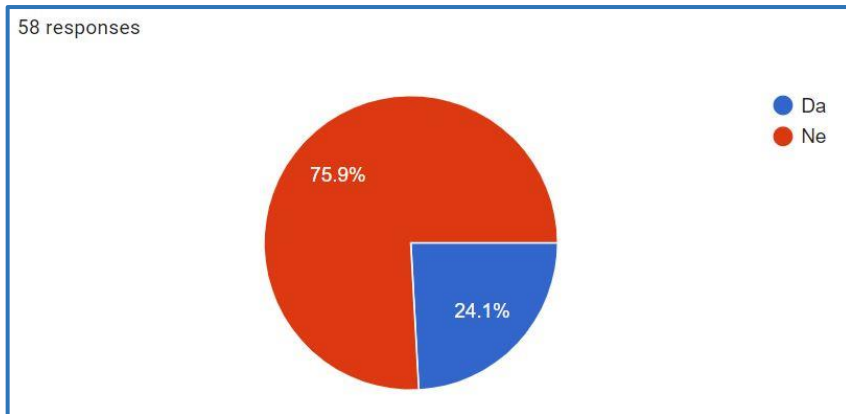

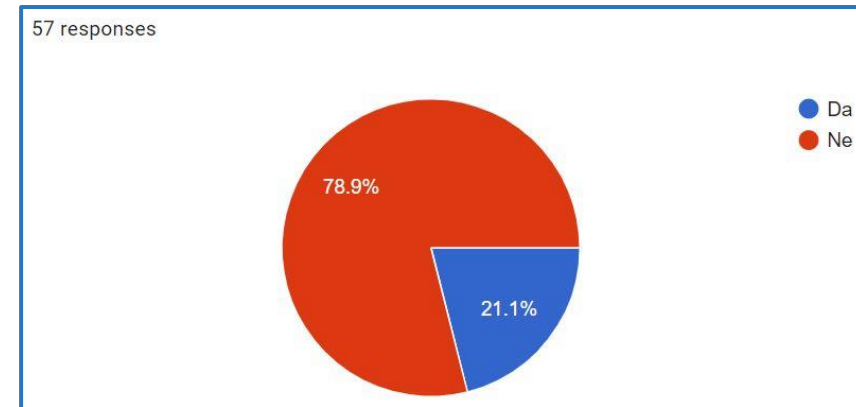

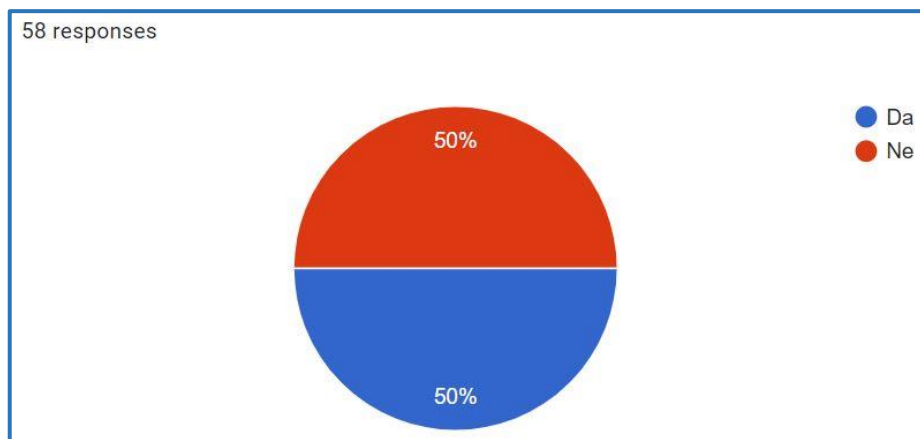

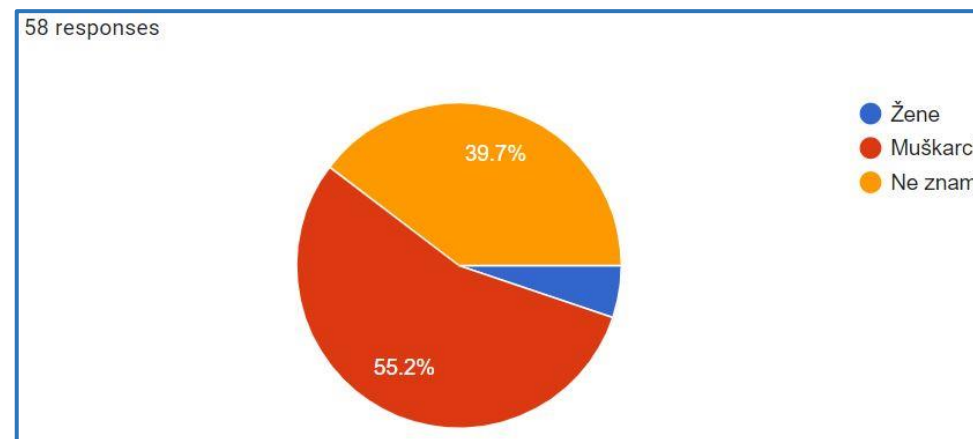

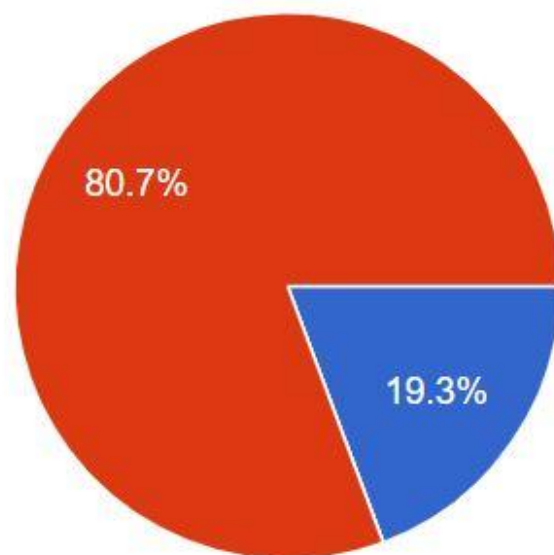

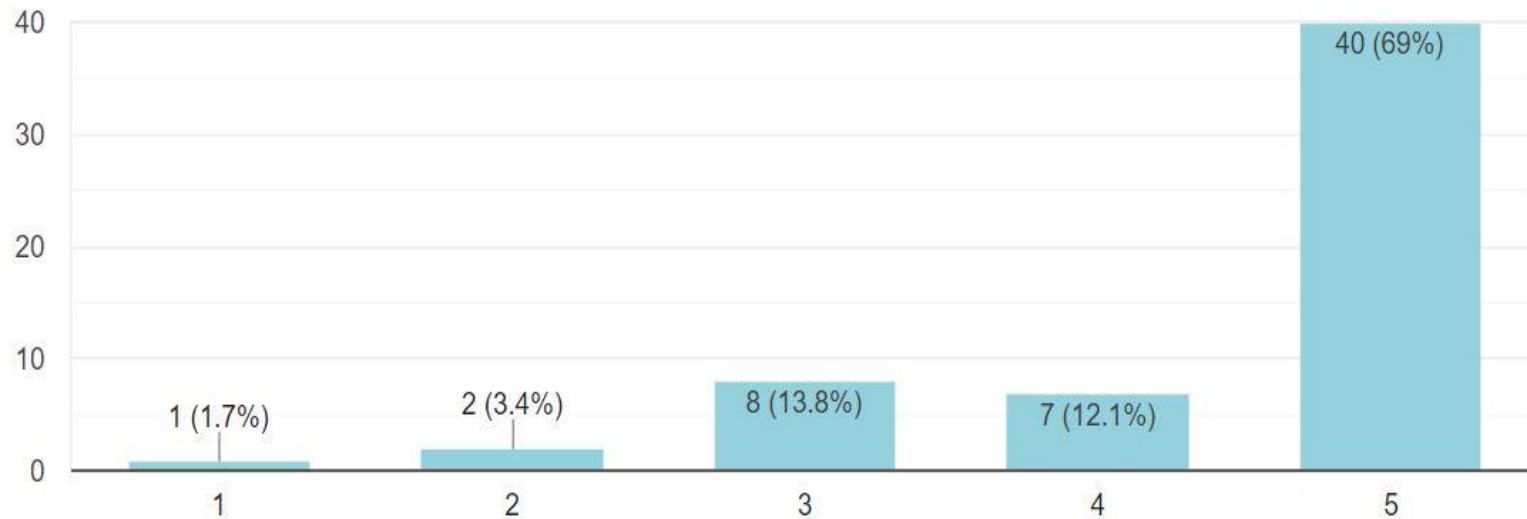
