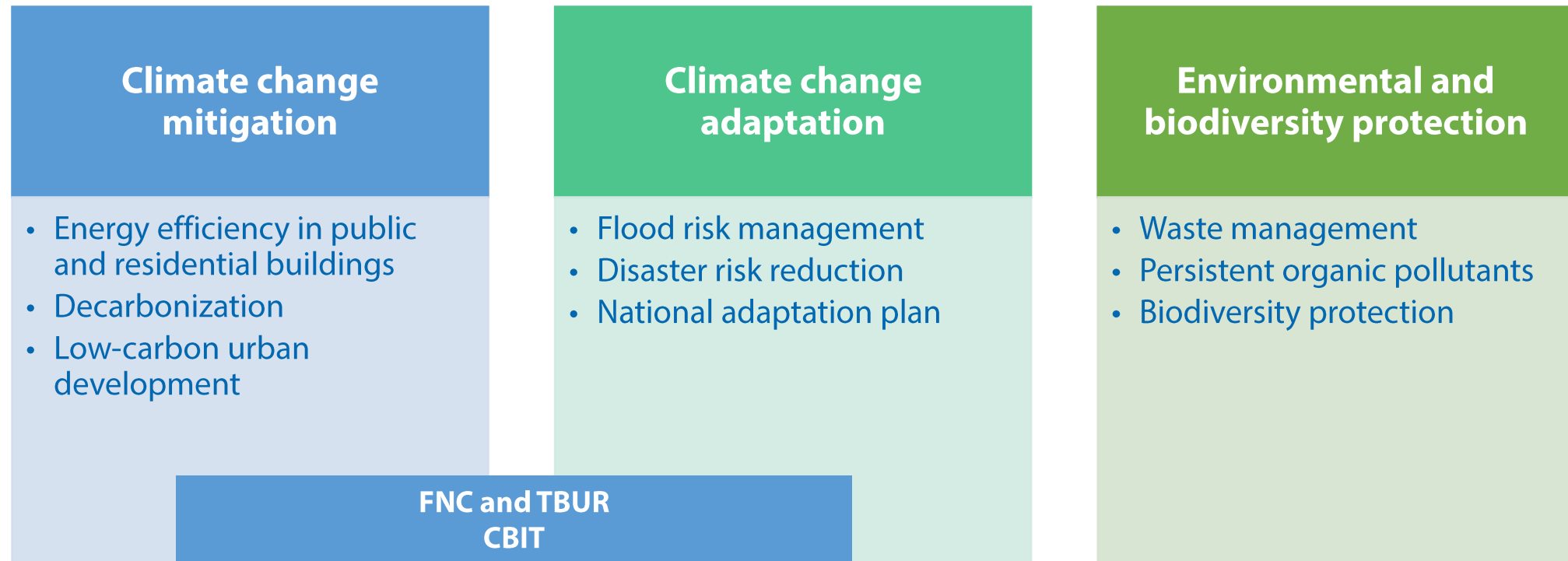

program for gender mainstreaming in Paris Agreement, in all CC-related activities, **in particular adaptation measures and capacity building activities**

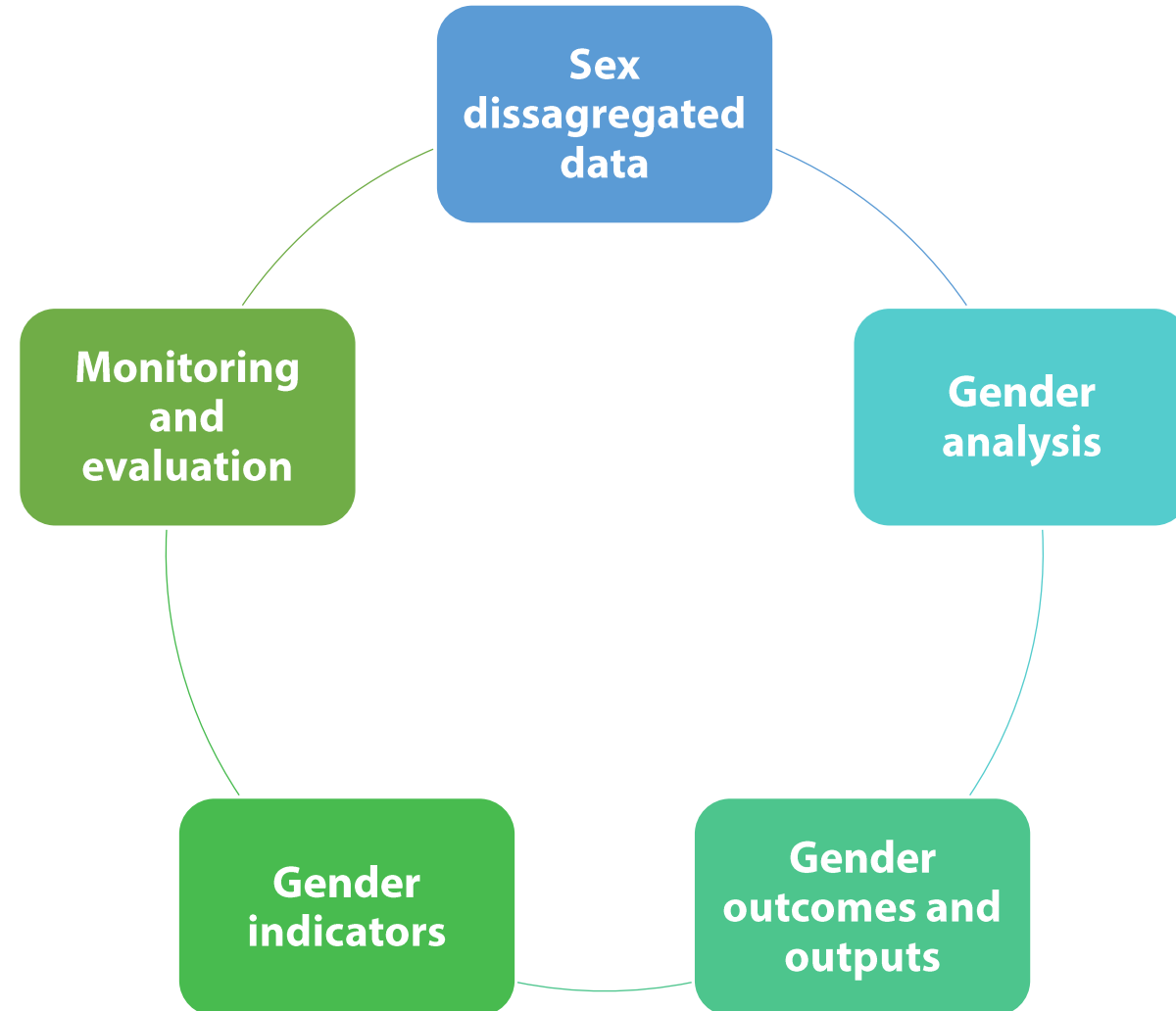
2017. UNFCCC:

Institutional learning – gender mainstreaming



Framework for analysis of inclusion of gender dimension

NEEDS	Do the policy / practice / project meet the identified needs of women and men?
APPROACH	Do women and men (as employees and among the population) have access to the rights, benefits and / or resources arising from a particular policy / practice / project?
PARTICIPATION	Were women and men involved in the design, implementation and evaluation of the policy / practice / project?
RESOURCES	Is the distribution of resources (financial, equipment ...) equal and in accordance with the identified needs of women and men?
INFLUENCE	What is the impact of the policy / practice / project on women and men (as employees and among the population)?



Example: Gender considerations in flood risk management activities

UTICAJ ŽIVE NA ZDRAVLJE VAS I VAŠEG DJETETA

Prema Svjetskoj zdravstvenoj organizaciji (WHO) živa je svrstana u jednu od 10 hemikalija sa najštetnijim uticajem po javno zdravlje čijem su djelovanju izloženi ljudi i životinje. Kada jednom dospije u organizam, živa se akumulira u masnom tkivu. Posteljica (placenta) trudnice nije zaštićta za plod, stoga duži kontakt sa živom tokom trudnoće može uzrokovati ozbiljne probleme Vama i Vašoj bebi.

Bebe izložene živi dok su još u materici mogu imati kao posljedicu oštećenja mozga, sluha i vida. Ozbiljnost oštećenja obično ovisi o dužini izlaganja te o količini žive kojoj ste bili izloženi, minimalne su šanse da dođe do ozbiljnih posljedica po bebu uslijed npr. udisanja para izlovene žive iz toplomjera.

AMALGAMSKE PLOMBE

U slučaju potrebne prilikom popravka zuba zahtijevajte kompozitne plombe koje su sigurna alternativa amalgamskim plombama jer ne sadrže živu.

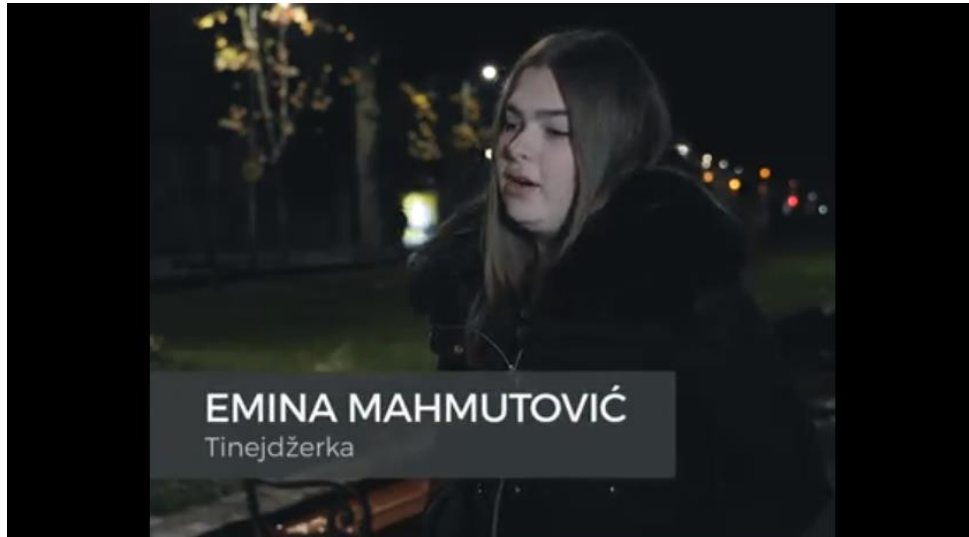

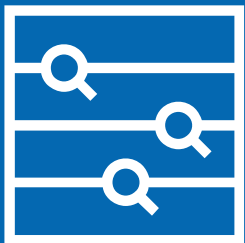

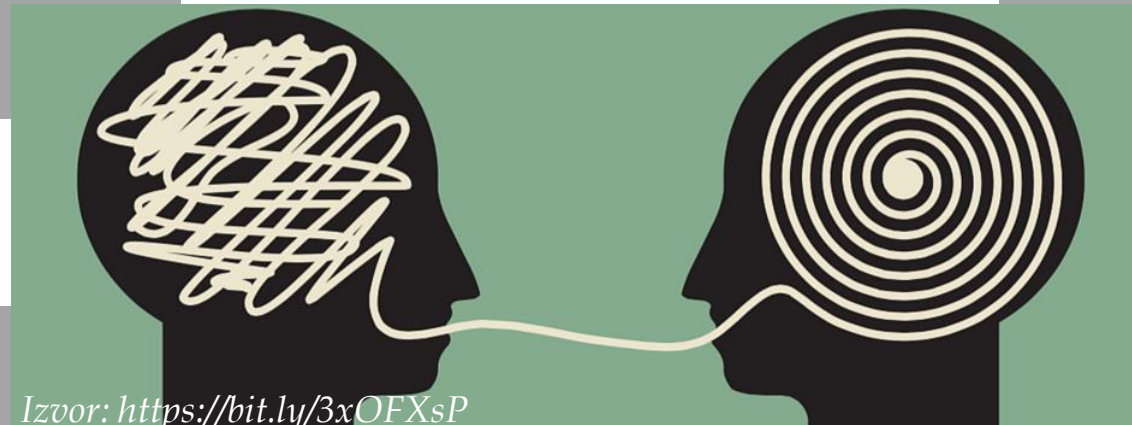
